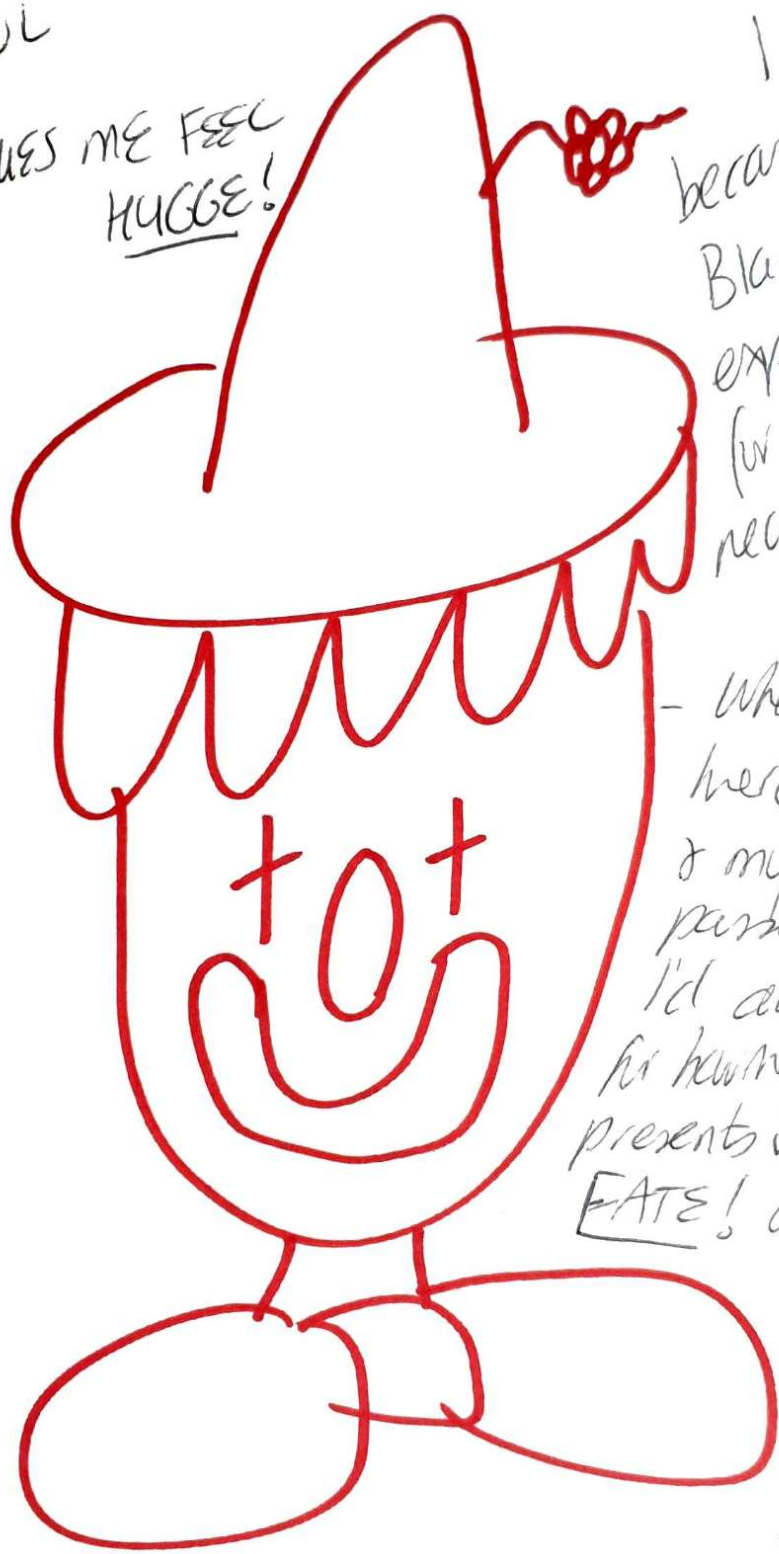


WOOLWICH IS

REMOVE from WOOLWICH

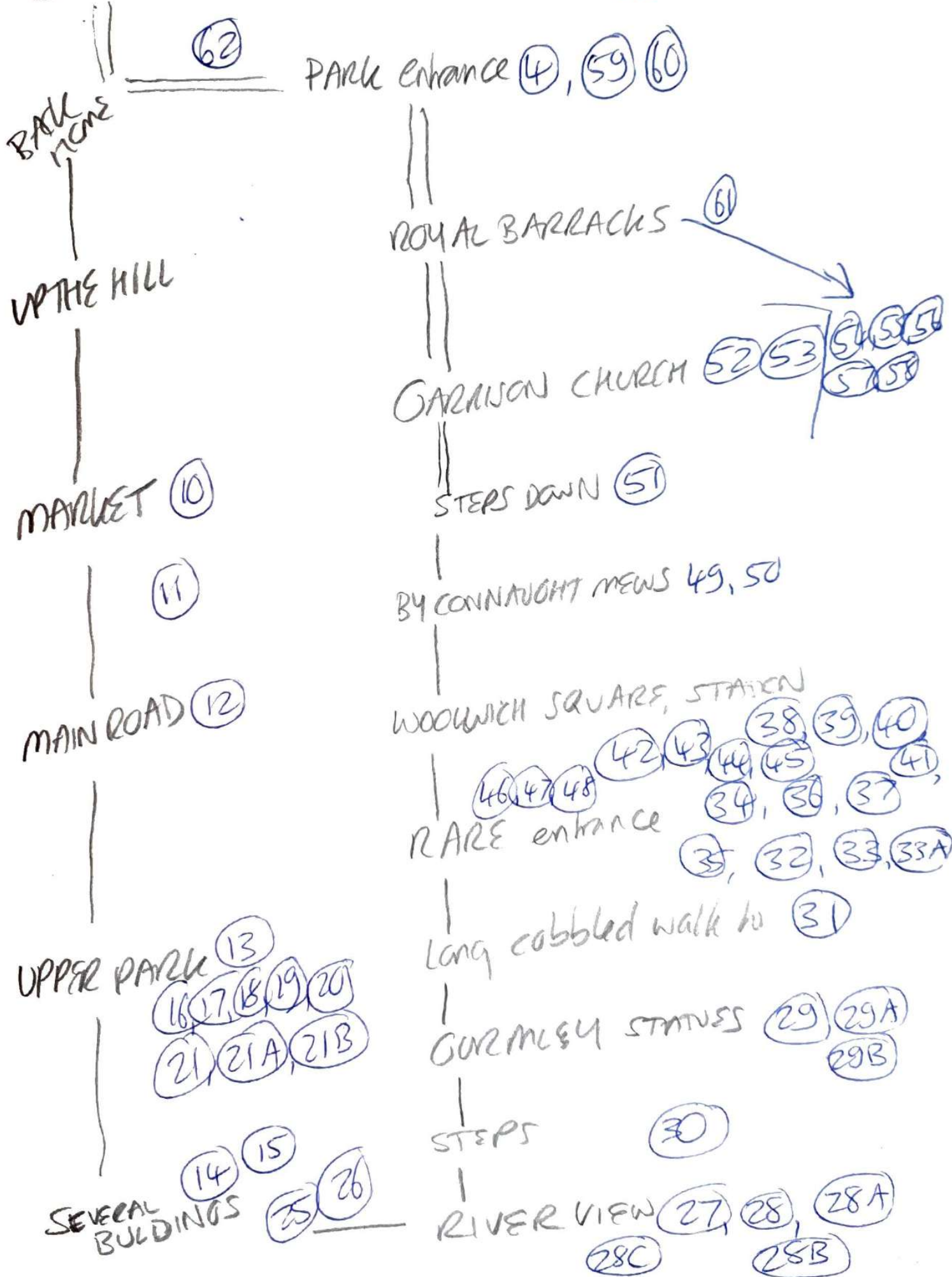

Back up the steps to the castle

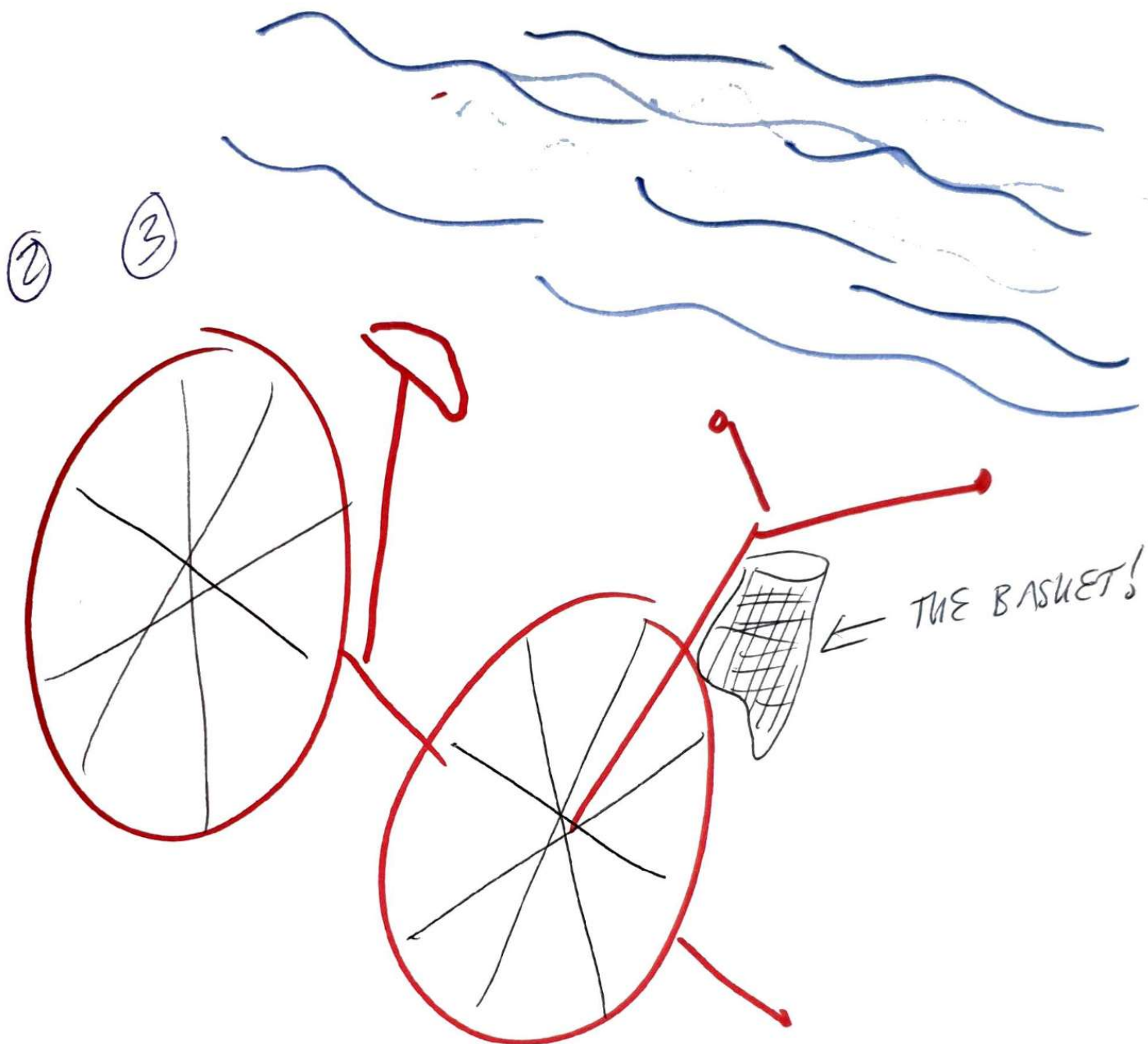
Castle to nearest bus stop!

MY OFFICE

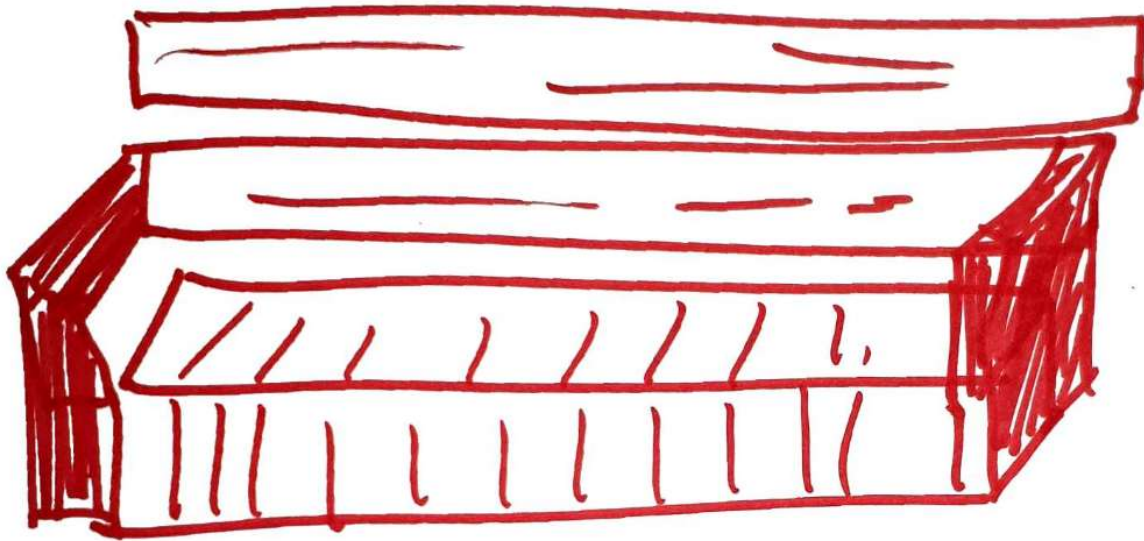
I'm lucky to have my office to work in especially ^{COVID} times
